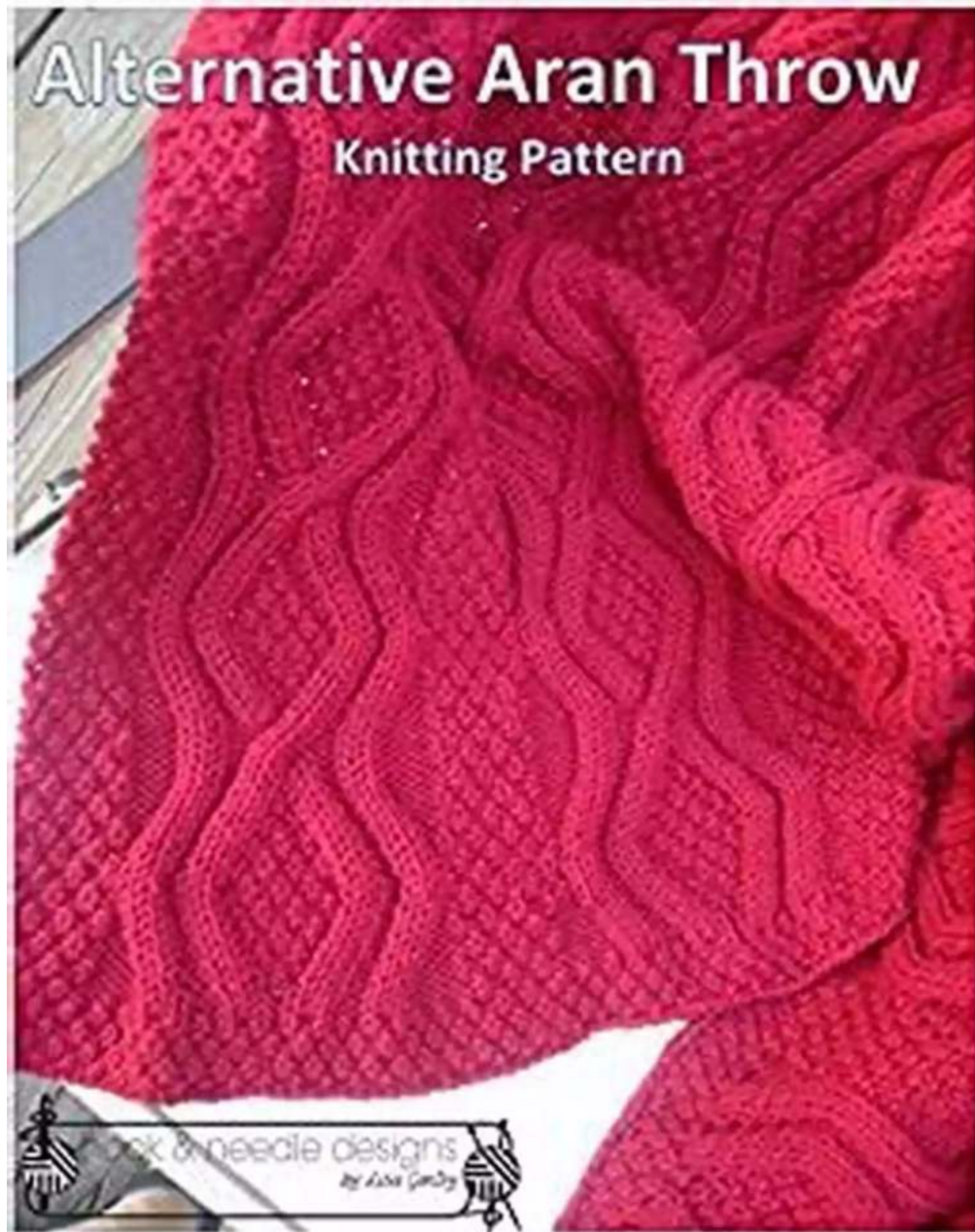

Yarn: CARON® INTERNATIONAL One Pound™ (acrylic; 16oz/454g = 812yd/742m) #562 Claret: 3 skeins

Knitting Needles: Size US 7 (4.5mm) circular, 32"/80cm or longer. Size US 9 (5.5mm) circular, 32"/80cm or longer, or size to obtain gauge.

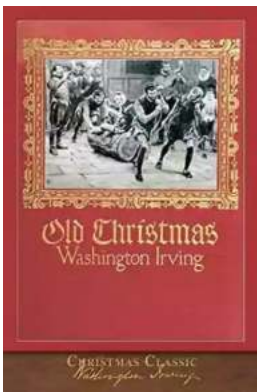
Additional Materials: 2 cable needles, Stitch markers (optional)
