- A crochet hook (size: G/4.0mm)
- Yarn (yellow, black, red, and green)
- Fiberfill stuffing
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors
- Stitch markers

The Amigurumi Bee

- 2) 4 ply yarn (cream, green, pink, red, yellow, orange, black, white, purple and brown)
- 3) Polyester fiberfill
- 4) Twelve 4 mm black beads for eyes

5) Tapestry needle

6) Sewing needle and thread for attaching eyes
